The project for Loose Cannon saw Cool Energy construct a **60 pallet wide walk-in modular cold store** providing on-site cooling for casks of Real Ale. The cold store contained the most energy-efficient panels and refrigeration pack available on the market, and helped reduce the carbon impact of the new business and maintain low power costs on site.
